Competition: Skiathlon – A Skiathlon is a mass start event (in waves) in which both the classical and free technique are used with equipment change at mid-distance. The first half of the race is competed in classical technique while the latter half is raced in the free technique. The ski equipment change takes place in special changing area by the stadium.
