

Windsor Park AGM Report (Fall 2024)

Last season was a dismal combination of excessive labor and barely any snow.

We were open for 18 days in January then 10 days in early March for a total of 28 days

The snowmaking operation was a steep learning curve and despite the challenges turned out well culminating in a Spring Cup relay thanks to the Boundry trails club. This event turned out to be a great season ending finale.

New Capital Expenses in the form of a tractor, Wood Chipper, wood splitter, and Manure (snow) spreader. Added to our previous acquisitions of tiller and snowmaker fan gun and round out our ability to make snow as has been our long term plan.

Our main groomer of the past 2 years, Marlow stopped working with us at the end of last season New Groomer, Trails keeper, has been hired: Tristan Schneider.

Trail improvement, realignment and creation of some new trails along with 8 New lights was accomplished last fall. This work is continuing this year with 3 more lights and more trail grading and contouring donated from a generous neighbour.

Applied for "From the Ground UP" grant for additional trail work and snowmaking infrastructure. 2Phase project : lights and trail work this season, snowmaking infrastructure next season.

WPNC committee formed and is performing well. 8-10 person committee

New garage project to support our capital acquisitions and the snowmaking operation is proceeding. Budget is estimated to be about \$400,000 , 50% of which is required to be matched.

Fundraising and donor recognition campaign is being planned.
